

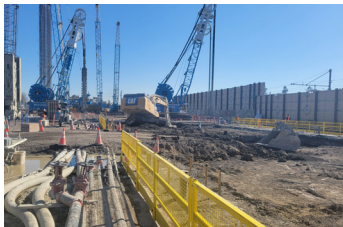

Muir Woods Salmon Habitat Enhancement

Project Cost: \$1.8M | Project Fee: \$68K

Period of Performance: 06/1/2020-01/31/2022

The \$1.8M Muir Woods Salmon Habitat Enhancement project restored Redwood Creek to a natural, healthy ecosystem by removing riprap and creating natural pools. Keish provided stormwater compliance oversight, developed and implemented SWPPPs and REAPs, coordinated with the National Park Service and contractors, conducted discharge sampling, and prepared Annual Reports.

Matadero Creek Outfall & Bank Restoration Project

Project Cost: \$400K | Project Fee: \$100K

Period of Performance: 11/15/2024-11/14/2025

A fuel spill at the VA Palo Alto Hospital revealed a damaged stormwater outfall to Matadero Creek, requiring repair and bank stabilization. Keish managed permitting and compliance, secured regulatory approvals, designed the bioengineered outfall, and prepared the Habitat Mitigation and Monitoring Plan. The team also supported construction and post-construction monitoring to ensure long-term project success.
